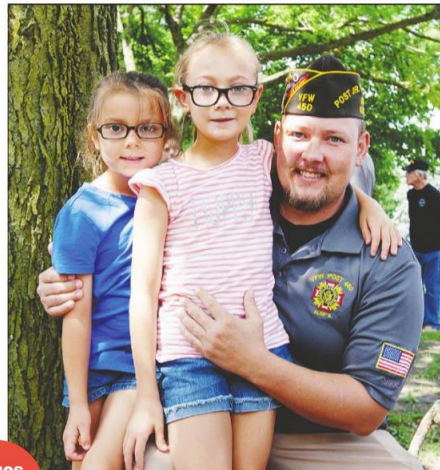

Veterans gather for Korean War memorial event

Korean War veterans from Illinois and Indiana joined their families at the Korean War memorial in Kennedy Park on July 28 to honor the 65th anniversary of the signing of the armistice ending the Korean War. Organized by the Windy City Veterans, 19th Ward officials and Smith Senior Living, the event included a motorcycle caravan, raising the flags of the U.S. and the Republic of Korea, a wreath laying and remarks from representatives of the U.S. Marine Corps and local veterans organizations. An honor guard paid tribute to those who served, and honor riders from Alsip's VFW Post 450 welcomed residents of the Illinois State Veterans Home in Manteno (top right). Lawrence and Shelly Myszkowski (bottom left) came from Bridgeview to attend the event, and Keith Krull brought his daughters, Kayleigh and Kennedy, from Alsip (bottom right).
